RESTORATION OF THE **SPIRIT**:

When we are born again in Christ we are a _____ **II Cor.5:17**

The reborn spirit is born of God. This reconciles us to God. Our inward man (our spirit) is the “real” us. “Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new _____ within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh”. **Ezek. 11:19**

“We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be _____ from the body and to be _____ with the Lord”. **II Cor. 5:8** The inward man and the soul go into the presence of God at physical death.

RESTORATION OF THE **SOUL**:

The soul of man is composed of the mind, will and emotions. It is our responsibility to renew and take charge of our soul. This is done by the power of God’s Word. Your mind is restored and renewed when you learn God’s way of thinking, speaking and acting.

“For the word of God *is* _____ and _____, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.” **Hebrews 4:12**

RESTORATION OF THE **BODY**:

The body is the outward physical man. We are all very aware that the physical body dies. **Matt. 4:4** tells us that man shall not live by bread alone, but by every _____ from the mouth of God. The physical body contacts the physical realm (the 5 senses). We are to rule and control our bodies. The flesh wars against our spirit. The body wants to do its own thing with no regard to right and wrong. For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing _____ dwells; for to will is present with me, but *how* to perform what is good I do not find. **Romans 7:18** The “flesh” is a way of thinking and doing that does not line up with God. We are to “put on” Jesus Christ and **Romans 13:12-14** make no provision for the _____, to *fulfill its* lusts.

We must walk in the Spirit in order for our bodies to be under control. **Galatians 5:16-24** tells what the works of the flesh are and what the fruits of the spirit are:

You must subdue (say no) to the body and **I Thess. 5:22** Abstain from every form of _____.

Romans 6:11-14 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.**12** Therefore do not let _____ reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.**13** And do not present your members *as* instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to _____ as being alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God.**14** For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
